

**VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE IS April 9, 2018, at 9:00 P.M.**

All residents of Williams County, who wish to vote in the May 8, 2018 Primary Election, must have an up to date voter registration. Your properly completed voter registration form must be **postmarked** or **received** by the 30<sup>th</sup> day before the election in which you wish to vote. Individuals who have changed their name and/or address since the last election, **MUST** report this change. You may obtain and/or return a registration form from the following public offices: Board of Elections, any public library, high school, or vocational school, BMV, Department of Job and Family Services, WIC Office, or the County Treasurer's Office. Or you may go to [www.MyOhioVote.com](http://www.MyOhioVote.com) to change your address or for further information regarding voter registrations. In order to vote in the May 8, 2018, Primary Election, you must have a valid photo ID, Military ID, or a current (within last 12 months) utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, government check, or other government document that shows the voter's name and current address.
