## **Williams County Launches Prescription Drug Discount Card That Can Be Used by ALL Residents**

### *Discount Cards Offering Average Savings Of 22 Percent Off Retail Price*

[July 13, 2009] — Williams County today launched a discount card program to help consumers cope with the high price of prescription drugs. The county is making free prescription drug discount cards available under a program sponsored by the National Association of Counties (NACo) that offers average savings of 22 percent off the retail price of commonly prescribed drugs.

The cards may be used by all county residents, regardless of age, income, or existing health coverage, and are accepted at 100 percent of the county's pharmacies. A national network of more than 59,000 participating retail pharmacies also will honor the NACo prescription discount card.

"Williams County is proud to be one of the counties nationwide participating with NACo," said Commissioner Hilbert. "The NACo prescription discount card offers significant savings for the uninsured and underinsured residents of our county, and even those fortunate to have prescription coverage can use the card to save money on drugs that are not covered by their health plan. Residents do not have to be Medicare beneficiaries to be eligible for this program."

Best of all, there is no cost to county taxpayers for NACo and Williams County to make these money saving cards available to our residents.

Cards will be available at the following offices in Williams County: Commissioners' Office, Job & Family Services, Health Department, Hillside, Sheriff's Office, EMS Building, Title Office, Common Pleas Court, OSU Extension Office, Soil & Water Office, Enrichment Center, Department of Aging, Juvenile Probate Court, and all Senior Centers and Pharmacies. The Commissioners will be personally distributing the cards to all pharmacies within the next couple of days. County residents can call toll free 1-877-321-2652 or visit [www.caremark.com/naco](http://www.caremark.com/naco) for assistance with the program.

"Using the NACo prescription discount card is easy," said Commissioner Hilkert. "Simply present it at a participating pharmacy. There is no enrollment form, no membership fee and no restrictions or limits on frequency of use. Cardholders and their family members may use the card any time their prescriptions are not covered by insurance."

The discount card program is administered by CVS Caremark.
