Mary's Corner: Mary Thaman

Hopefully, you will be celebrating Thanksgiving and Christmas with family but if you're alone share a meal with friends in the same situation. Consider buying a turkey breast to roast since most people prefer white meat. Not being one of them, I buy fresh thighs only available the week of Thanksgiving. One cooked thigh will make 2 servings plus enough for 1-2 sandwiches.

Of course you'll want pumpkin pie for dessert and Libby's recipe for pie is on the label and has stood the test of time and the only one I use. Make the pie or fill custard cups with the filling and bake in an oblong tin half full of water (just like you do when you make baked custard). Bake until a knife inserted in the center comes out clean. Serve with a dollop of softened cream cheese. The cream cheese complements the filling more than whipped cream or whipped topping would. Just be sure to refrigerate any leftovers.
