IS IT REALLY GOOD FOR YOU?

When you're grocery shopping, here's a good rule of thumb: Be wary of the healthy-sounding words on the food packages. Almost 70 percent of consumers in a new survey of 100 people from the Consumer Reports National Research Center said they use the front-of-package information when deciding whether to buy processed food for the first time but it's probably not helping them make better choices. Many terms and phrases aren't regulated by the Food and Drug Administration or the Department of Agriculture. Sometimes, a product's name implies a health attribute. But it may not be. Take Pacific Organic Soup. The regular version has 750 milligrams per cup per serving. Have it with a few saltines and you've consumed 20 percent of the maximum amount of sodium you should have in a day. Better yet, make your own tomato soup.

TOMATO BASIL SOUP

2 cups seeded tomatoes	1 cup low sodium tomato juice
¼ cup fresh basil leaves	½ cup low-fat milk
1/8 teaspoon salt	1/8 teaspoon black pepper
1/4 cup 1/3 less fat cream cheese, softened	Basil leaves thinly sliced for garnish

Bring tomatoes and juice to a boil in a medium saucepan. Reduce heat; simmer, uncovered, for 30 minutes. Use an immersion blender if you have one to puree mixture. Otherwise, place in blender or food processor and process until smooth (about 5 minutes). Return pureed mixture to pan; stir in milk, salt and pepper. Add cream cheese, stirring well with a whisk, and cook over medium heat until thick, about 5 minutes. Ladle soup into individual bowls; garnish with sliced basil. Refrigerate remaining soup in an airtight container for up to 1 week. Recipe makes 4 servings.
