## Mary's Corner: Mary Thaman

Better Breakfast Month in September inspired me to share a breakfast idea from my daughter, Mary Ann. She freezes pancake batter in 1/2 cup portions that when thawed and baked makes 2 pancakes. Top with fresh fruit or maple syrup. Pancake batter can be "from scratch" or made with a mix like Bisquick. I'm thinking you will prefer one made with a mix. That said, my recommendation is the recipe on the Bisquick Heart Smart box.

### BLUEBERRY PANCAKES

1 cup Bisquick Heart Smart mix  
2/3 cup fat-free skim milk or whatever kind you drink  
2 tablespoons fat-free egg product or beaten egg  
3/4 cup fresh blueberries  
Stir ingredients except blueberries until blended.  
Gently stir in blueberries before baking.  
Pour slightly less than 1/4 cupful's onto greased griddle.  
Cook until bubbles break on surface. Turn; cook until golden.  
Makes 9 pancakes.
