"Eat like a king for breakfast, a queen for lunch and a pauper at night." If you're eating your noon meal at our senior centers, you're most certainly dining like a queen (maybe a king). But if you're a late morning riser there's a good chance that you probably skip breakfast all together. Rise and shine earlier and make a "Western Omelet in a Mug."

Ingredients:

2 large eggs	1 tablespoon milk
1 tablespoon chopped onion	2 tablespoons chopped bell pepper
2 slices deli ham	1 tablespoon reduced fat sharp Cheddar cheese
Salt and pepper to taste	

Directions:

Coat the inside of a 16-ounce mug with cooking spray. Crack eggs into mug and whisk until completely combined. Whisk in milk, onion, bell pepper, ham and season with salt and pepper. Microwave on high for 1 minute. Stir the eggs, top with cheese and cook an additional 30 to 60 seconds on high or until eggs are completely set. Remove from microwave and eat immediately. Note: Cook time will vary slightly from microwave to microwave (my appliance is 1,100 watts.)
