Today, the ball weighs 11,875 pounds, is twelve feet in diameter and has over 2,668 Waterford crystals attached to it.
 - Over 1 ton confetti is dropped in Times Square at 12:00 a.m. on New Years
 - There are about 40 time zones, so New Years Eve is celebrated at 40 different times.
- Top 3 destinations in the United States for New Year's Eve are: New York City, Las Vegas and Walt Disney World.
- Top globally is Sydney, Australia as you can see over 80,000 fireworks go off over the famed Sydney Opera House.
- The traditional way to usher in New Year's is by singing "Auld Lang Syne," transcribed and published by poet Robert Burns. The title is said to mean "times gone by." & has been used for New Year's Eve since 1896
